



North Atlantic Figure Skating Club Club Ice Guest Coaching Requirements

Guest Coaches are defined as those who are not home club members/coaches of the North Atlantic Figure Skating Club (NAFSC), who are not actively coaching in the NAFSC Learn to Skate USA program, and who are not Associate Coaches under NAFSC.

All guest coaches shall adhere to all policies and protocols set forth by the NAFSC Board of Directors, the PSA Tenets of Professionalism and Code of Ethics, and U.S. Figure Skating.

Guest Coaches wanting to coach on NAFSC Club Ice are required to provide the following to the NAFSC club office **BEFORE** getting on the ice:

- Signed liability waiver
- Signed coach code of conduct
- Copy of current US Figure Skating membership card
- Copy of current US Figure Skating coaching compliance card
- Certificate showing completion of SafeSport training
- Copy of current liability insurance
- Proof of Professional Skaters Association membership (PSA card)
- Copy of CER certifications

Guest coaching fee is \$8/session or \$15 per day and must be paid **prior** to taking the ice. You may also pre-pay for guest coach walk on tickets at \$15 each and then turn them in each day you coach.

All guest coaches **must** check in with the NAFSC office prior to taking the ice.
