

FAMILY ICE CENTER FACILITY RULES AND GUIDELINES:

1. Family Ice Center will restrict the number of participants for on-ice activities according to CDC guidelines.
2. All rink patrons and staff must wear a face covering (mask) over their mouth and nose when inside the building, including on the ice.
3. Guests are asked to social distance and must abide by rink signage directing the flow of foot traffic.
4. Individuals experiencing a fever, cough, or ANY other symptoms consistent with COVID-19 will be prohibited from entering the arena.
5. Children are to be dropped off/picked up outside the facility. There will be no spectators allowed in the arena. Very young children can be briefly accompanied by one adult for assistance prior to and immediately following their session.
6. As a precaution, locker rooms may be unavailable, so patrons are asked to arrive at the rink wearing the majority of their equipment. Designated group spaces will be outlined on the Locker Room Assignment Board located as you enter the building in the Main Lobby.
7. Guests must leave valuables and personal items at home as Family Ice Center will no longer maintain a Lost & Found.
8. Skaters can enter the rink no sooner than fifteen minutes prior to your ice time. Skaters must leave the facility within ten minutes after their session has concluded. All skaters will enter in the main lobby and move immediately to the designated side of the rink. The designated side will have its own bathroom for use and its own exit.
9. Guests must leave valuables and personal items at home as Family Ice Center will no longer maintain a Lost & Found.
10. Employees will clean and sanitize all public areas using CDC-approved disinfectants.
11. Hand sanitizer stations will be located throughout the facility.
