



**North Atlantic Figure Skating Club
Club Ice
Associate and Guest Coach Requirements and Responsibilities**

All associate and guest coaches, defined as those coaches who are not NAFSC home club members/coaches of the North Atlantic Figure Skating Club (NAFSC) and who are not actively coaching in the NAFSC Learn to Skate USA program, shall adhere to all policies and protocols set forth by the NAFSC Board of Directors, the PSA Tenets of Professionalism and Code of Ethics, U.S. Figure Skating, and U.S. Figure Skating SafeSport.

To coach on NAFSC Club Ice, we must be able to verify the following, or these must be provided by the coach:

- A valid and current U.S. Figure Skating Membership (club, individual, or LTS USA depending on level of skaters)
- Completion of SafeSport Training (18 years or older)
- A passed U.S. Figure Skating Background check
- The Professional Coach/Choreographer CER
- Coach liability insurance
- Signed NAFSC Coach Code of Conduct
- Signed Waiver and Release of Liability

FEES

Associate coach fee: \$ 5 per session/\$8 per day
Guest coach fee: \$ 8 per session/\$15 per day

Daily coaching fees must be paid promptly upon invoice. Associate and guest coaches may also purchase a 10-session punch card at the per session rate.

All associate and guest coaches **must** check in/sign in before getting on the ice.
