

## **Senior Scholarship Program**

The NAFSC Board would like to award High School Seniors who have been active participants in NAFSC throughout their high school career to receive recognition for their participation and commitment to the club.

All Graduating Seniors will be recognized at the NAFSC end of the year banquet and on any social media platforms currently being used by the club.

The Senior Scholarship in the amount of \$200 will be awarded to Graduating Seniors, at the end of the year banquet, who have been outstanding participants in the NAFSC organization and have meet the criteria outlined below:

1. The skater must be a member of the North Atlantic Figure Skating Club (NAFSC) and U.S. Figure Skating, both in good standing.
2. The figure skater must have a practiced a minimum of 100 hours of freestyle ice yearly during their time in high school. This is time spent on the ice training, not time competing, rehearsing for shows and exhibitions, or time purchased via ice cards or bulk credit programs.
3. The figure skater must have participated in at least three NAFSC Annual Ice Show during their time in high school.
4. The figure skater must have completed 6 volunteer hours yearly during their time in high school either through Junior Coaching, volunteering at club events or participating in/ running Kids Club.

*Any exceptions to the above criteria can be submitted to the committee for review and voted on by the board.*
